4-H Is for Everyone!

4-H is the largest youth serving organization in the world. Anyone between the ages of 8 and 18 can join 4-H. You can join an existing club or you can start your own 4-H club.

4-H offers boys and girls fun, friends and learning. 4-H encourages families to work together on projects and activities and attend meeting and community events together. Members choose projects that fit their interests. Group activities and events such as camps, trips, workshops, junior leaders, performing arts, achievement days and conferences provide additional opportunities and learning experiences outside the club membership experience.

While 4-H had its beginnings in rural America, 4-H now is for everyone—urban and rural.

To Become a Member...

- Fill out an enrollment form and join a club.
- Select projects from a list of over 50 projects.
- Attend club meetings and project workshops.
- Build, raise or make projects to exhibit at the County Achievement Days.
- Participate in club activities: community service, recreation, tours and trips.
- Keep a journal of 4-H work done.
- Read the county newsletter and 4-H column to keep informed of 4-H events.
- Participate in county 4-H activities that are of interest.



The Codington County 4-H provides hands-on, real life experiences through projects, activities and events. 4-H members learn new things by completing dozens of different kinds of projects. They go on trips, have parties, participate in local government, experiment with science, make art, go to camp or take care of an animal. Youth have the opportunities to learn leadership, citizenship, character and life skills. The cost to join is only \$1.50 or \$2.50 (horse members) to cover 4-H insurance.
