

*Court Admin Staff is currently located in Brookings. Presently includes Circuit Court Administrator, Circuit Court Admin Support Staff, and Chief Court Services Officer. We are anticipating the addition of new FTE position of Circuit Clerk of Court within next 5 years.

The Future of the Court

- 1) Senate Bill 70.
- 2) Drug Court – 2 new FTE Staff.
- 3) Vet Court – Pilot program being run with no additional staff.
- 4) Magistrate needs. Needs of the Circuit call for a second Magistrate Judge. This position will be located in Watertown. Along with this position will be a Court Recorder.
- 5) Clerk needs indicate a future need for more staff. We will be requesting additional staff to compensate with the increase in workload created with the increased complexity of the Clerk of Courts job.
- 6) DUI Court – Specialty courts work and are being implemented statewide. This trend will continue until there is a Drug Court and DUI Court in every city that dictates a need.
