


THE POTENTIAL PROBLEM: NOISE

OUR SOLUTION

- 1. <u>Keeping our numbers low</u>. We are not going to go over-capacity of what the board approves. Additionally, we keep the number of dogs in the run at a time, limited to same members of a family.
- 2. <u>Insulation and acoustics</u>. All products we have purchased and plan to purchase for our boarding house have acoustics in mind. We want to keep as much noise inside the building. Using high NRC value products take care of it for us. From the rubber mats in each dog kennel to the insulation and wall panels. I research each product before we buy it to make sure it has good NRC ratings!
- 3. White noise & music. Research has proven that music helps relax dogs. We always have dog music playing when we are boarding dogs.

We take complaints seriously. If one of neighbors has a noise complaint we are going to work tirelessly to come up with a solution as quickly as possible. We do not want to be 'those neighbors.'

THE POTENTIAL PROBLEM: SMELL (DOG WASTE)

OUR SOLUTION

- 1. Daily Cleanup: To keep our area clean we clean up the dog run each day.
- 2. Weekly Disposal: We will take weekly trips to the dump to dispose of waste.
- 3. Bugs: Use of metal trash cans. This helps keep bugs and critters out of it until we dispose of it.
- 4. Future Option Composting
 - a. There is a method of using worms to help compost dog waste.
 - b. Doing it correctly should not have smell
 - c. More research is needed before we execute this.
 - d. Location of the compost site would be at the southern-most end of our property.

We take complaints seriously. If one of neighbors has a smell complaint we are going to work tirelessly to come up with a solution as quickly as possible.

THE POTENTIAL PROBLEM: SAFETY

OUR SOLUTION

- 1. Client Policies
 - a. Vaccinations Must be up to date on vet recommended vaccines. We call and track vaccinations for all of our clients.
 - b. Leash upon entry and exit All dogs must be leashed when arriving and departing from our home.
 - c. Supervision Dogs will NEVER be left unsupervised when outside.
 - d. Keeping our numbers low this avoids potential escapes and dog fights.
 - e. Fencing We plan to have a double fence system with privacy on the eastern side of the dog run. If a dog did escape the first fence, we will have a secondary fence bordering the run for added security.
- 2. Cameras
 - a. We have multiple cameras setup inside the boarding house as well as on the exterior of the home.
 - i. Motion Tracking, Motion Alerts, Sound Alerts All sent to our phones.
